



### 2011/2012 HEALTH AND WELFARE SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into this <u>1st day of December, 2011</u> by and between the Board of Education of the Central Islip Union Free School District (hereinafter "CENTRAL ISLIP"), having its principal place of business for the purpose of this Agreement at 50 Wheeler Road, Central Islip, New York, and the Board of Education of the South Country Central School District (hereinafter "South Country"), having its principal place of business for the purpose of this Agreement at 189 Dunton Avenue, East Patchogue, New York.

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, CENTRAL ISLIP is authorized pursuant to Section 912 of the Education Law, to enter into a contract with South Country District for the purpose of having CENTRAL ISLIP School District provide health and welfare services to children residing in South Country School District attending a non-public school located in the CENTRAL ISLIP School District,

WHEREAS, certain students who are residents of South Country are attending non-public schools located in the CENTRAL ISLIP School District,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Agreement, the parties hereby mutually agree as follows.

- 1. The term of this Agreement shall be from September 8, 2011 through June 24, 2012 inclusive.
- 2. CENTRAL ISLIP School District warrants that the health and welfare services will be provided by licensed health care providers. CENTRAL ISLIP School District further represents that such services shall be performed by health care providers that are licensed under the laws of the State of New York, including New York State Department of Health and the State Education Department licensing requirements, if applicable. CENTRAL ISLIP School District further represents that such services will be in accordance with all applicable provisions of Federal, State, and local laws, rules, and regulations, including Section 912 of the Education Law, and the student's IEP, if applicable. CENTRAL ISLIP School District shall certify that all service providers possess documentation evidencing such license qualifications as required by Federal, State, and local laws, rules, regulations and orders.
- 3. CENTRAL ISLIP School District understands and agrees that it will comply and is responsible for complying will all applicable Federal, State, and local laws, rules and regulations with respect to the services provided pursuant to this Agreement.
- 4. The services provided by CENTRAL ISLIP School District shall be consistent with the services available to students attending public schools within the CENTRAL ISLIP School District; and may include, but are not limited to:

- all services performed by a physician, physician assistant, dentist, dental a. hygienist, registered professional nurse, nurse practitioner, school psychologist, school social worker, or school speech therapist,
- dental prophylaxis, b.
- vision and hearing screening examinations, C.
- the taking of medical histories and the administration of health screening d.
- the maintenance of cumulative health records, and e.
- the administration of emergency care programs for ill or injured students. f.

### It is expressly understood and agreed between the parties that the services to be provided pursuant to this Agreement shall not include any teaching services.

- In exchange for the provision of health and welfare services pursuant to this Agreement, 5. South Country agrees to pay CENTRAL ISLIP School District the sum of \$911.80 per eligible pupil for the 2011-2012 school year.
- 6. South Country shall pay CENTRAL ISLIP School District within thirty (30) days of South Country's receipt of a detailed written invoice from CENTRAL ISLIP School District. Said invoice shall specify the services provided, dates that the invoice covers, and the total amount due for the period specified.
- If, during the term of this Agreement, a student becomes eligible to receive services 7. pursuant to this Agreement, CENTRAL ISLIP School District shall undertake to provide services pursuant to this Agreement, and the amount of compensation owed by South Country shall be prorated accordingly to accurately reflect the period of time services were provided to the student.
- If, during the term of this Agreement, a student ceases to be eligible to receive services 8. pursuant to this Agreement, CENTRAL ISLIP School District shall no longer be responsible for providing services to that student pursuant to this Agreement, and the amount of compensation owed by South Country be prorated accordingly to accurately reflect the period of time services were provided to the student.
- CENTRAL ISLIP School District shall furnish any supplies or equipment necessary to 9. provide the services pursuant to this Agreement to the extent such items are not provided by the non-public school.
- 10. Both parties agree to provide the State access to all relevant records which the State requires to determine either CENTRAL ISLIP or South Country School District's compliance with applicable Federal, State, or local laws, rules, or regulations with respect to provision of services pursuant to this Agreement. Both parties agree to retain all materials and records relevant to the execution or performance of their obligations pursuant to this Agreement in accordance with the record retention requirements for such materials and records.

- 11. Both parties to this Agreement understand that they may receive and or come into contact with protected health information as defined by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA). The parties hereby acknowledge their respective responsibilities pursuant to HIPAA and shall comply with said Regulations, if applicable.
- Both parties, their employees, and/or agents agree that all information obtained in connection with the services performed pursuant to this Agreement is deemed confidential information. Both parties, their employees, and/or agents shall not use, publish, discuss, disclose or communicate the contents of such information, directly or indirectly with third parties, except as provided for in this Agreement. Both parties further agree that any information received by either party's employees and/or agents in connection with this Agreement which concerns the personal, financial, or other affairs of the parties, their employees, agents, and/or students will be treated as confidential and will not be revealed to any other persons, firms, organizations, or third parties. In addition, both parties agree that information concerning any student covered by the terms of this Agreement shall not be released except as provided for by applicable law, rule, or regulation, including but not limited to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
- 13. Services provided pursuant to this Agreement shall be provided without regard to race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, religion, age, disability, or sponsorship.
- 14. All notices which are required or permitted under this Agreement shall be in writing, and shall be deemed to have been given if delivered personally or sent by registered or certified mail, addressed as set forth above.
- 15. It is expressly understood that this Agreement shall not be assigned or transferred without prior written consent of the other party.
- 16. The failure of either party to enforce any provision of this Agreement shall not be construed as a waiver or limitation of that party's right to subsequently enforce every provision of this Agreement.
- 17. Should any provision of this Agreement, for any reason, be declared invalid and/or unenforceable, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Agreement. Such remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect as if this Agreement had been executed with the invalid provision(s) eliminated.
- 18. This Agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties hereunder shall be construed in accordance with, and governed by, the laws and regulations of the State of New York and applicable Federal laws and regulations.
- 19. This Agreement is the complete and exclusive statement of the Agreement between the parties, and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous, oral or written: proposals,

understandings, representations, conditions or covenants between the parties relating to the subject matter of the Agreement.

- This Agreement may not be changed orally, but only by an Agreement, in writing, signed 20. by authorized representatives of both parties.
- It is mutually agreed that this contract shall not become valid and binding upon either 21. party until the contract is approved by the Superintendent of Schools of the South Country School District (district of residence).



### CONSULTANT SERVICES CONTRACT

This Agreement is entered into this \_\_\_\_\_\_day of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, 2012 by and between the Board of Education of the South Country Central School District (hereinafter the "DISTRICT"), having its principal place of business for the purpose of this Agreement at 189 Dunton Avenue, East Patchogue, New York 11772, and Developmental Disabilities Institute (hereinafter "CONSULTANT"), having its principal place of business for the purpose of this Agreement at 99 Hollywood Drive, Smithtown, New York 11787.

### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS the DISTRICT is authorized under the Education Law to contract with private schools within the State of New York for the instruction of students with disabilities in those situations where the DISTRICT is unable to provide for the education of such students with disabilities in special classes in the schools of the DISTRICT; and

WHEREAS CONSULTANT is a registered nonpublic school chartered by the Board of Regents of the University of the State of New York as a non-profit educational corporation authorized to establish, conduct, operate, and maintain an educational program for children with disabilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree as follows:

#### A. TERM

The term of this Agreement shall be from 1/2011 through 6/30/412 inclusive, unless terminated early as provided for in this Agreement. It is understood that the DISTRICT is under no obligation to renew this Agreement upon its expiration.

### B. SERVICES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- During the term of this Agreement, CONSULTANT shall provide educational services to those students listed on the attached "Schedule A" in accordance with Part 200 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education and applicable law.
- 2. The CONSULTANT shall provide the services set forth in this Agreement to those student(s) referred by the DISTRICT in writing and at the times, frequency, and for the period therein specified. Payment for students added or removed shall be prorated for the period during which services were rendered.
- 3. If applicable, all services provided by CONSULTANT to students under this Agreement shall be in accordance with each student's Individualized Education Plan (IEP), as it may be modified from time to time. Prompt written notice shall

be given by the DISTRICT to the CONSULTANT upon any modification of a student's IEP. The DISTRICT shall obtain whatever releases, prescriptions or other legal documents are necessary for the CONSULTANT to perform its services pursuant to this Agreement.

- 4. CONSULTANT shall perform all services under this Agreement in accordance with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, rules, and regulations, as well as established policy guidance from the New York State Education Department, including those related to the discipline of students with disabilities.
- 5. CONSULTANT shall comply with all applicable provisions of the Safe Schools Against Violence in Education (SAVE) Act, including, but not limited to background checks and fingerprinting of all staff directly providing services to students. To the extent applicable, all persons providing services to the DISTRICT pursuant to this Agreement must receive clearance for employment by the New York State Education Department prior to the provision of such services.
- 6. CONSULTANT represents that all services under this Agreement shall be provided by qualified individuals of good character, and in good professional standing. CONSULTANT shall be responsible for orientation and training of its own staff. CONSULTANT represents that no individuals providing services under this Agreement are currently charged, nor in the past have been charged with any relevant criminal or professional misconduct or incompetence.
- 7. At the DISTRICT'S request, CONSULTANT shall provide copies of required licenses/certifications of all professionals providing services to student(s) under this Agreement. In the event that the required license/certification of any agent or employee of CONSULTANT providing services under this Agreement is revoked, terminated, suspended, or otherwise impaired, CONSULTANT shall immediately notify the DISTRICT in accordance with the requirements for all notices pursuant to this Agreement set forth below.
- 8. CONSULTANT shall observe and comply with all applicable DISTRICT Policies and Regulations while on the grounds of the DISTRICT or providing services pursuant to this Agreement.
- 9. CONSULTANT shall provide all services pursuant to this Agreement in a competent, professional, and timely manner.
- 10. CONSULTANT will work cooperatively with the Committee on Special Education (CSE), the Committee on Pre-School Special Education (CPSE), the DISTRICT'S administrative staff, and medical staff. The CONSULTANT shall make relevant personnel available to participate in meetings of the DISTRICT'S CSE or CPSE when appropriate, upon reasonable prior notice to the CONSULTANT of such meetings.
- 11. CONSULTANT shall maintain records, logs, and/or reports in accordance with all applicable laws, regulations, requirements of the New York State Education

Department or Health Department and DISTRICT policies and procedures in force during the term of this Agreement. The DISTRICT shall have the right to examine any or all records or accounts maintained and/or created by the CONSULTANT in connection with this Agreement, and upon request shall be entitled to copies of same.

- 12. Both parties to this Agreement understand that they may receive and/or come into contact with protected health information as defined by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA). The parties hereby acknowledge their respective responsibilities pursuant to HIPAA and shall comply with said Regulations, if applicable.
- Both parties, their employees, and/or agents agree that all information obtained in connection with the services performed pursuant to this Agreement is deemed confidential information. Both parties, their employees, and/or agents shall not use, publish, discuss, disclose or communicate the contents of such information, directly or indirectly with third parties, except as provided for in this Agreement. Both parties further agree that any information received by either party's employees and/or agents in connection with this Agreement which concerns the personal, financial, or other affairs of the parties, their employees, agents, and/or students will be treated as confidential and will not be revealed to any other persons, firms, organizations, or third parties. In addition, both parties agree that information concerning any student covered by the terms of this Agreement shall not be released except as provided for by applicable law, rule, or regulation, including but not limited to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
- 14. In the event that the parent or person in parental relation to a student(s) receiving services pursuant to this Agreement initiates litigation in connection with such services, CONSULTANT shall promptly give written notice of same to the DISTRICT.
- The DISTRICT reserves the right to reject any of the CONSULTANT'S staff, which the DISTRICT, at its sole discretion, may deem unqualified.
- 16. CONSULTANT shall maintain its status as an approved school for the education of children with disabilities. Failure to do so shall render this agreement void. The DISTRICT shall not be responsible for services rendered during any period in which CONSULTANT has failed to maintain its status.
- 17. CONSULTANT shall maintain monthly attendance records which shall be submitted to the District quarterly. In the event a student is absent from instruction for a period of (5) consecutive days or more, the student's record shall indicate the reason for said absences. Authorized absences include sickness, family emergency, or the death of an immediate family member. CONSULTANT shall notify the District immediately in the event the student has an unauthorized absence of (5) days or more. CONSULTANT shall not discharge a student without prior authorization of the DISTRICT.

18. CONSULTANT shall attempt to provide substitute coverage in the event of the absence of the regularly scheduled service provider. The services of the substitute provider shall be in accordance with all terms and conditions of this Agreement.

#### C. <u>INSURANCE</u>:

- 1. CONSULTANT, at its sole expense, shall procure and maintain such policies of commercial general liability, malpractice and other insurance as shall be necessary to insure the CONSULTANT and the DISTRICT, including the Board of Education, employees and volunteers, as additional insured, against any claim for liability, personal injury, or death occasioned directly or indirectly by CONSULTANT in connection with the performance of CONSULTANT'S responsibilities under this Agreement; each such policy shall provide a minimum coverage of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence subject to an annual aggregate of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000).
- 2. The insurance is to be underwritten by a licensed and/or admitted New York State Insurer with a minimum Bests rating of A-minus.
- 3. In the event any of the aforementioned insurance policies are cancelled or not renewed, the CONSULTANT shall notify the District in writing within thirty (30) days of such cancellation or non-renewal.
- 4. Upon the execution of this Agreement, CONSULTANT will supply the DISTRICT with a Certificate of Insurance including the DISTRICT, Board of Education, Employees and Volunteers as Additional Insured, a copy of the Declaration pages of the policies, and a copy of the additional insured endorsement.

#### D. COMPENSATION:

- 1. The DISTRICT shall pay CONSULTANT for services in accordance with the terms of the attached "Schedule A", incorporated by reference herein and made a part of this agreement. Any adjustment in the tuition rate set forth in Schedule "A" approved by the Commissioner of Education shall be applied to the next and all subsequent invoices following receipt by CONSULTANT of such determination by the Commissioner. The furst adjusted bill shall include documentation from the Commissioner of such change. Any change shall be applied retroactively.
- 2. The CONSULTANT shall submit invoices for payment on a monthly basis. All invoices shall include the services provided, the total hours, the dates that the invoice covers, and the total amount due for the period specified. The DISTRICT shall pay CONSULTANT within thirty (30) days of the DISTRICT'S receipt of such invoice.

- 3. The DISTRICT shall give the CONSULTANT notice of any invoice disputes within twenty (20) days of its receipt of the invoice, and reserves the right to withhold payment pending the resolution of the dispute.
- Neither CONSULTANT nor any of its personnel shall share or accept any fee or gratuity for services provided pursuant to this Agreement except as expressly set forth in this Agreement.
- 5. CONSULTANT shall bear the cost of all expenses incurred as the result of doing business, including, but not limited to all fees, fines, licenses, bonds or taxes as well as the cost of all tools, vehicles or other equipment necessary for the implementation of services pursuant to this agreement.

### E. <u>MISCELLANEOUS</u>

#### 1. Termination:

- a. Either the CONSULTANT or the DISTRICT may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party. Such notice shall be given in accordance with the requirements for all notices pursuant to this Agreement set forth below.
- b. The parties agree that CONSULTANT'S failure to comply with any terms or conditions of this Agreement will provide a basis for the DISTRICT to immediately terminate this Agreement without any further liability to CONSULTANT
- c. In the event the CONSULTANT or the DISTRICT terminates this Agreement with or without cause, such termination shall not discharge the parties' existing obligations to each other as of the effective date of termination.

### 2. Independent Contractor:

- a. CONSULTANT will be engaged as an Independent Contractor, and therefore be solely responsible for the payment of federal and state income taxes applicable to this Agreement.
- b. Neither CONSULTANT nor any of its employees, agents, or assigns will be eligible for any employee benefits whatsoever relative to this contract including, but not limited to, Social Security, New York State Worker's Compensation, unemployment insurance, New York State Employee's Retirement System, health or dental insurance, or malpractice insurance, or the like.
- c. The DISTRICT, if required by Federal or State requirements, will submit a Form 1099 and IT 2102.1 respectively at year-end to the Federal

Government for all individuals having a gross income exceeding \$600, which thereupon will be reported for income tax purposes.

#### 3. Defense / Indemnification:

a. CONSULTANT agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the DISTRICT, its officers, directors, agents, or employees against all claims, demands, actions, lawsuits, costs, damages and expenses, including attorneys' fees, judgments, fines and amounts arising from any willful act, omission, error, recklessness or negligence of the CONSULTANT, its officers, directors, agents or employees in connection with the performance of services pursuant to this Agreement. The obligations pursuant to this provision shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

#### 4. Notices:

a. All notices which are required or permitted under this Agreement shall be in writing, and shall be deemed to have been given if delivered personally or sent by registered or certified mail, addressed as follows:

- 7. Should any provision of this Agreement, for any reason, be declared invalid and/or unenforceable, such decision shall not effect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Agreement. Such remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect as if this Agreement had been executed with the invalid provision(s) eliminated.
- 8. This Agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties hereunder shall be construed in accordance with, and governed by, the laws and regulations of the State of New York and applicable Federal laws and regulations. Any dispute arising under this Agreement shall be litigated in the Courts of Nassau County, New York.

- 9. This Agreement, is the complete and exclusive statement of the Agreement between the parties, and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous, oral or written: agreements, proposals, understandings, representations, conditions or covenants between the parties relating to the subject matter of the Agreement.

\$750 per day for coaching for a total of \$2,250 for this contract.


#### **BACKGROUND RATIONALE:**

Two consultation days will be planned to present effective teaching practices using differentiated instruction and curriculum modifications in the Self-Contained classroom setting. Consultation incorporates classroom visits and meeting time with staff.

Location- Bellport High School and Frank P. Long Intermediate School Classrooms

An additional consultation day will be planned to present team teaching strategies in the Co-Teaching classrooms.

**Location**- Middle School Co-teaching classrooms

Consulting That Makes A Difference, Inc. of 71 Riviera Drive Selden, NY 11784 (the "Service Provider")

### Service Agreement

#### BACKGROUND:

- 1. The Customer is of the opinion that the Service Provider has the necessary qualifications, experience and abilities to provide services to the Customer.
- 2. The Service Provider is agreeable to providing such services to the Customer, on the terms and conditions as set out in this Agreement.

IN CONSIDERATION OF the matters described above and of the mutual benefits and obligations set forth in this Agreement, the receipt and sufficiency of which consideration is hereby acknowledged, the parties to this Agreement agree as follows:

### **Engagement and Scope of Services**

 Service Provider shall provide three days of coaching during the 2011-2012 school year (dates to be determined).

#### Term of Agreement

2. The term of this Agreement will begin on the date of this Agreement and will remain in full force and effect until June 22, 2012.

<u>Performance</u>

3. Both parties agree to do everything necessary to ensure that the terms of this Agreement take effect.

Compensation and Payment Schedule

4. In full consideration for the services to be rendered by SERVICE PROVIDER to CUSTOMER for the term of this Agreement, CUSTOMER agrees to pay SERVICE PROVIDER \$750 per day for coaching for a total of \$2250 for this contract. SERVICE PROVIDER will submit an invoice for services rendered and payment to SERVICE PROVIDER shall be made within thirty days from receipt of invoice from SERVICE PROVIDER.

Cancellation Policy

5. CUSTOMER must notify SERVICE PROVIDER of a cancellation of a scheduled consultation date in advance of 14 calendar days of scheduled date. Cancellation of a scheduled consultation date within less than 14 calendar days from scheduled date must be rescheduled within 30 days of original scheduled date or SERVICE PROVIDER agrees to pay for cancelled date in full according to the compensation and payment schedule set forth in this agreement.

**Modification of Agreement** 

6. This Agreement may only be altered, amended, or modified by written assignments signed by all the parties hereto.

**Independent Contractor** 

7. SERVICE PROVIDER acknowledges that she will not hold herself as employees of SCHOOL DISTRICT. SERVICE PROVIDER is retained by SCHOOL DISTRICT only for the purposes and the extent set forth in this Agreement, and her/his relationship to SCHOOL DISTRICT shall, during the periods of her services hereunder, be that of an independent contractor. SERVICE PROVIDER shall not be considered as having employee status and shall not be entitled to participate in any of SCHOOL DISTRICT's workers' compensation, retirement, fringe benefits, unemployment insurance, liability insurance, disability insurance, or other similar employee benefit programs. Similarly, SERVICE PROVIDER shall not be considered as having employee status for the purposes of any other rights, privileges or benefits derived from employment by SCHOOL DISTRICT. SERVICE PROVIDER agrees that this Agreement does not confer benefits of any nature whatsoever upon her other than payment for services provided herein. SERVICE PROVIDER shall not assert any claim for additional benefits of any nature, including, but not limited to, unemployment compensation benefits, by reason of the services to be performed pursuant to this Agreement. SERVICE PROVIDER shall not be entitled to assert any claim to entitlements pursuant to any collective bargaining agreement now or hereafter in effect between SCHOOL DISTRICT and its employees.
